

Disarmament and Non-Proliferation Education

SECURING FUTURE

The objective of Disarmament and Non-Proliferation Education (DNPE) and training is to impart knowledge and skills to individuals. This empowers people to make their contribution, as national and world citizens, to the achievement of concrete disarmament and non-proliferation measures. It also helps us all to contribute to the ultimate goal of general and complete disarmament under effective international control.

It offers an opportunity for deeper analysis of conflict and conflict resolution, the causes of war and the interaction between technology and warfare, emphasizing approaches to reducing and eliminating violent conflicts of all kinds.

UN Resolutions and Recommendations

In October 2002, the United Nations Study on Disarmament and Non-Proliferation Education (A/57/124) was submitted to the First Committee of the General Assembly to revitalize past disarmament education efforts. It provided 34 recommendations for action to be undertaken by Member States, the UN Office for Disarmament Affairs and its regional centres, academia, civil society, media and others.

In 2017, these 34 recommendations were reaffirmed by the Secretary-General's Advisory Board on Disarmament Matters (A/72/185). In its report, the Board called again for a reinvigoration of disarmament education activities.

Collective Action

Civil society organizations and the media have often taken a leading role in providing both formal and informal disarmament and non-proliferation education and training.

By joining together Member States, the UN System and other international organizations can collectively prepare, adapt and disseminate a wide range of targeted, user-friendly educational materials on disarmament.



New technologies

New technologies, especially the Internet and social media, create unprecedented opportunities in disarmament and non-proliferation education for both academic audiences and
