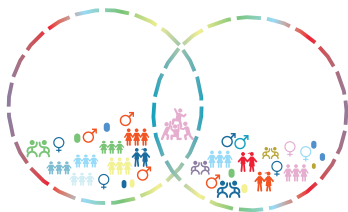
### Cooperation

Greater efforts are needed to **achieve equal, full and effective participation of women** in all decision-making processes related to disarmament.



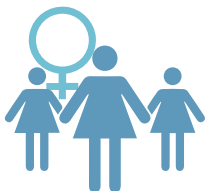
**More education and training opportunities** should be established, in order to **empower young people** to be a **force for change and disarmament**.
